Rules and Guidelines

Please review the following rules for the workcamp. Your cooperation in all areas is appreciated!

Schedules

Everyone is expected to adhere to the workcamp schedule and participate in all activities for the week. This begins with registering on time (Sunday, beginning at 1:00pm) and continues through the last program (Saturday beginning at 8:15am).

School

Please respect the school by keeping it clean and not damaging anything in the classroom or other parts of the building. If property is damaged by your group, you will be responsible for the necessary repairs and/or costs to replace.

Meals

Plan to eat the meals prepared for the workcamp. You may bring in snacks to eat during free time, but do not plan to bring in food for meals or eat out (with the exception of Wednesday evening).

Lights Out

Everyone is expected to be in bed and quiet by 10:45 PM each night. People require different amounts of sleep. Please respect those who require more than you, both at night and early in the morning.

Workcamp Enhancement

To enhance workcamp interaction for all those involved, the following are not permitted at the school, in vehicles or at the worksite: swearing, alcohol, drugs, fireworks, tobacco, radios, CD players, tape players or walkmans.

Secured Items

If you need to secure any personal items that you bring to workcamp, please bring your own lock. Lockers will be available if needed; however, you are responsible for bringing a lock. We encourage you to leave all expensive and unnecessary items at home!

Conduct
